

RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENTS FOR GUESTS AT HARRINIVA & KITILÄ

Clothes, according to the length of your stay and program:

Long sleeve shirts

Thin socks

Thick socks (best is to wear 1 pair of thin socks with 1-2 pairs of thick socks)

Thick and warm pullover

Thin (turtleneck) pullover

Long thermal underwear, sweat suit or similar to wear under the overall and in the huts

Jogging shoes, sandals or slippers to wear in the wilderness huts

Attention:

We recommend materials that are synthetic fiber, fleece, silk or wool

Please avoid cotton clothes and jeans!

Wear layers

Use comfortable clothes which are not too tight under overalls and in the huts

There is usually no electricity or running water in the huts during husky safaris!

Other:

Personal toilet articles (soap, shampoo, medicine etc.)

Towels (for all overnight safaris in the wilderness cabins)

Small rucksack for things that are needed during the safari days

Good sunglasses and suntan lotion in springtime

Head lamp and batteries

Camera and batteries

Thermos for warm beverages

Heat packs

Equipment provided by Harriniva for you:

Warm overall

Warm boots, balaclava, gloves, woollen hat and a pair of woollen socks

A sleeping bag with liner

Ski goggles for husky safari clients

Helmet for snowmobile safari clients

Attention:

We advise people with glasses to wear one day contact lenses.

Please pack your things in a soft large backpack or a bag. Try not to bring too many things, as it can easily get crowded in the cabins.

Things that you don't want to take with you on a safari, you can leave behind in Harriniva in a locked storage room. You can leave all valuables in our safe. (Tickets, money, passport, etc.)

If you are a vegetarian, have a special diet or a serious disease, please inform us well in advance - preferably when you reserve the safari!

Mobile phone coverage may not be available.

Insurance:

All our vehicles; snowmobiles and ATV (four wheelers) are insured, as required by the Finnish Traffic Insurance Act. This insurance covers medical care for injuries to the driver and the passenger arising from accidents. Own liability for vehicle damage is max. 550 €/accident.

We are not liable in general for personal injuries or material damage arising from accidents during other games and activities such as, dog or reindeer-sled safaris, canoeing, mountain-biking or other excursions. **Personal travel insurance is therefore highly recommended** and may be purchased from Five Stars of Scandinavia, Inc.

Other information:

During the snowmobile safari children are seated into the sledge pulled by the guide's Snowmobile.

During husky safari children are seated into sled which will be driven by our guide.

Driving a snowmobile or ATV under the influence of alcohol or any narcotic products is prohibited by Finnish law.

Depending on weather and snow conditions and for the safety and comfort matter of the others we reserve the right to change the routes and duration of the activities and safaris if necessary.

If our guest are noticed to be a potential harm or even danger to him/her, animals or to others, or is in poor health we also reserve the right to discontinue the safari.
